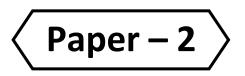

William Shakespeare

William Shakespeare was born on April 23, 1564 in the village of Stratford on Avon in the country of Walwickshire. It is father John Shakespeare was a son of farmer, John came to Stratford in about 1531, and began to prosper as a tracker in corn. It is nother Mary Orden was the claughter of prosperous garmer.

Of Shakispearc's education little is known For a few years he probably allended the Grammal school at stratford where he nicked up 'Small Latin und Less yreek'. He often played traast, took part in the uillage games. His 'astonishing store of natural knowledge' has been praised by all his critics.

When Shakispiare had attained the age of 14 his gather lost his little property and yell into debt. Therefore Shakispeare had to leave school to help and support the gamily of younger children. It is not exactly known what job he occupied for the next eight years but from evidences found in his plays, it is o maintained that he was a country school master and tawyers

In 1582 Shakispeare married Anne Klathway the claughter of a peasant. She was eight years older than Shakespeare flid to hondon to seek some fortune. There he joined Burbage's company of actors. According to a tradition, his reason for leaving stratford was that he had bun caught stialing a cleer from Sir Thomas ducy's park and he gled from Stratford to escape the consequences.

Iclis Life in London grom 1587 to 1611, nothing definite is known. It was the period of his greatest literary activity. Icle entired into the stiring life of England's Capital with the same perfect sympathy and understanding which he had shown among the simple folk of his native, Warwickshire. The came to be known anong his followers as "the gentle shakespeare"

Shakespeare's first work may well have been that of a general helper, an odd job man, about the theatre; but he soon betame an actor within two years he was at work on plays and his course was exactly like that of other^{SUNIDAY 08} his course was exactly like that of other^{SUNIDAY 08} playwrights of his time. Icle soon broke away from his apprentice work " and then appeared in quick succession.



Shakispiari's poims, rather than those early dramatic attempts, mark the biginning of his success. 'Venus and Adonis' became immensely popular in Kondon. It was dedi-(ated to the Earl of Southampton and brought from him a large amount of money as a gist. It is success and popularity grew enormously. Within a decade of his drival in Kondon, he had become one of the most fumous actors and leterary men in England.

Shakispiari's sonnets were composed between 1593 and 1601, though not published until 1609. That edition, 'The Sonnets of Shakispiare' consists of 154 sonnets, all written in the form of three quatrian and a couplet that is now recognized as Shakespearean. The sonnets fall into two groups: Sonnets 1-126, addressed to a beloved friend, a handsome and noble young man, and sonnets 12-152, to a muligrant but fastinating "Dark Lady", who the poit loves inspite of hinself. Mearly all of Shakespeare's sonnets examine the intuitable clean of time, and the inmortalization of beauty and love. in poetry.

Shakespeare wrote more than thirity plays. These are usually divided into your categories: histories, tomeclies, tragedies and romances. This carliest plays were primarily comeclies and histories such as Henry VI'and 'The Comedy of Errors' but in 15%, Shakespeare wrote Romeo and Tuliet, his second tragedy, and over the next dozen years he would return to the form, writing the plays for which he is known as best dramatist - Julius Caesar, Iclamlet, Othello, King hear, Macbeth and Antony and Cleopatra. In his sinal year Shakespeare turned to the romantic with Gymbeline, A winter's Jale and The Tempest

Only righteen of Shakespeare's plays were published seperately in quarto editions during his lightime; a complete collection of his works did not appear until the publication of the Evist Folio in 1623, several years after his death. Sometime agter 1612, shakespeare retired from the stage and returned to his home in Stratford. The drew up his will in Tanuary of 1616, which includes his famous beguest to his wife of his "Second best bed". Ite died on April 23 1616, and was buried two clays later at Stratford Church.
